



**1. From The Stafford Arms public house car park**, go to Lowe Lane. Turn Left and walk up the lane. Reaching Stainborough House, turn Right and cross the stile near the footpath sign. Follow the path through the wood (houses on your left). Bear left in the wood. Out of the wood bear right.

**2. Go over another stile** and over a field, over a stile and follow the path. Walk along the left hand side of a field up to the Left hand corner following arrows. Go over a stile and cross the former coalyard (charcoal).

**3. Go over a stile** and walk Straight up on the field. Reaching the sign with the arrows in the middle of the field, bear Right and go Straight to the end of the field. Go over a stile on your Left, then on your Right and finally up on your Left (after having passed a line of trees) up to a stile that you climb.

**4. Cross the road** and go Straight up into the greenery. Cross another road, and go to Creno View. Bear Right to the dead end "Lower and Stainborough Fold". Follow this road. Reaching farm buildings follow the path with a blue arrow sign.

**6. Once on Stainborough Lane**, turn Left (on your right, you can see two farms: the first Stainborough Lane Farm, and the second: Wood Nook). At the bend in the road, bear Left and take the footpath going over a stile. Go up the field for few meters along the right hand side.

**5. Go through a gate**, over a stile and down into a field [view: Thurgoland on the right, Crane Moor at the bottom of the valley, Top Pit Wood on your right hand side]. Before the bottom of the field, turn Left reaching a gate and cross the field diagonally to the wooden stile.

**7. Over a stile** on your Right following the path over 2 further stiles.

**8. Go Straight up** in a field and over a stile in the Right hand corner. You have now to cross Pocket Park (a playground) on the right hand corner.

**9. Reaching Bagger Wood Road**, turn Right. Bear Right again on Castle Drive and turn Left on Stainborough Lane. Turn Right on Lowe Lane [on your right is the entrance to Wentworth Castle (now a further education college) and the historic grade 1 listed Stainborough Castle Gardens] and continue to the junction with Gilroyd Lane. Bear Right to the Stafford Arms car park.
