

The Fox Walk

follow the yellow markers...

- 1 Go between the mill house & outbuildings; continue forward for approximately 50 metres then turn right onto a wooden bridge to cross the Mill Pond, once over the bridge turn left then immediate right up the ramp towards Worsbrough reservoir.
- 2 Cross the reservoir going over the two new spillways on your right; where the footpath ends turn right and in a short distance bear left going up a slight hill and through a metal gate.
- 3 Continue forward crossing a track and onto the Dove Valley Trail, turn left going under the railway footbridge. (The Dove valley Trail is a disused railway line which is part of the Trans Pennine Trail that runs from Liverpool to Hull, the trail can be walked or cycled from end - to - end).
- 4 In 1 kilometre the trail is crossed by another track; turning right will take you to Wigfield farm, an open farm with excellent café or turn left to continue on the walk going downhill towards the Reservoir.

- 5 At the bottom of the hill and with the reservoir in front of you take the track to the left keeping the reservoir on your right.
- 6 At the end of the footpath and ignoring the tarmac footpath across the top of the reservoir, continue forward and turn right down the hill with Worsbrough Mill and the Mill House visible in front.
- 7 At the base of the hill to your left can be seen dissecting the meadow a "Goyt" (stream). This was used to feed the Worsbrough Spur of the Dearne & Dove Canal and runs under the houses in the distance and also under the main A61 Sheffield road.
- 8 Where the track bears left, turn right over the two stone bridges, just over the second bridge turn right, you are now back at Worsbrough Mill Museum.

FOLLOW THE COUNTRY CODE
