Urban Farm

The farm is a member of the Rare Breeds Survival Trust, and they actively support their work to conserve endangered species. At the farm you can find rare breed animals including the British Lop and Gloucester Old Spot pigs, plus Whitefaced Woodland sheep. Other livestock include goats, cattle, rabbits and a large collection of poultry and waterfowl.



Directions

From the car park head back towards the entrance and turn right, up two flights of steps towards the field. Here take the middle of the three paths which climbs gently to the top of Sugarwell Hill. Just before the top of the hill fork right and follow the path down keeping the high bank to your left.

After passing the old stone barn turn right about 60 yards further on down the steps. Turn right here and follow the path alongside Meanwood Beck back to the farm and car park.
