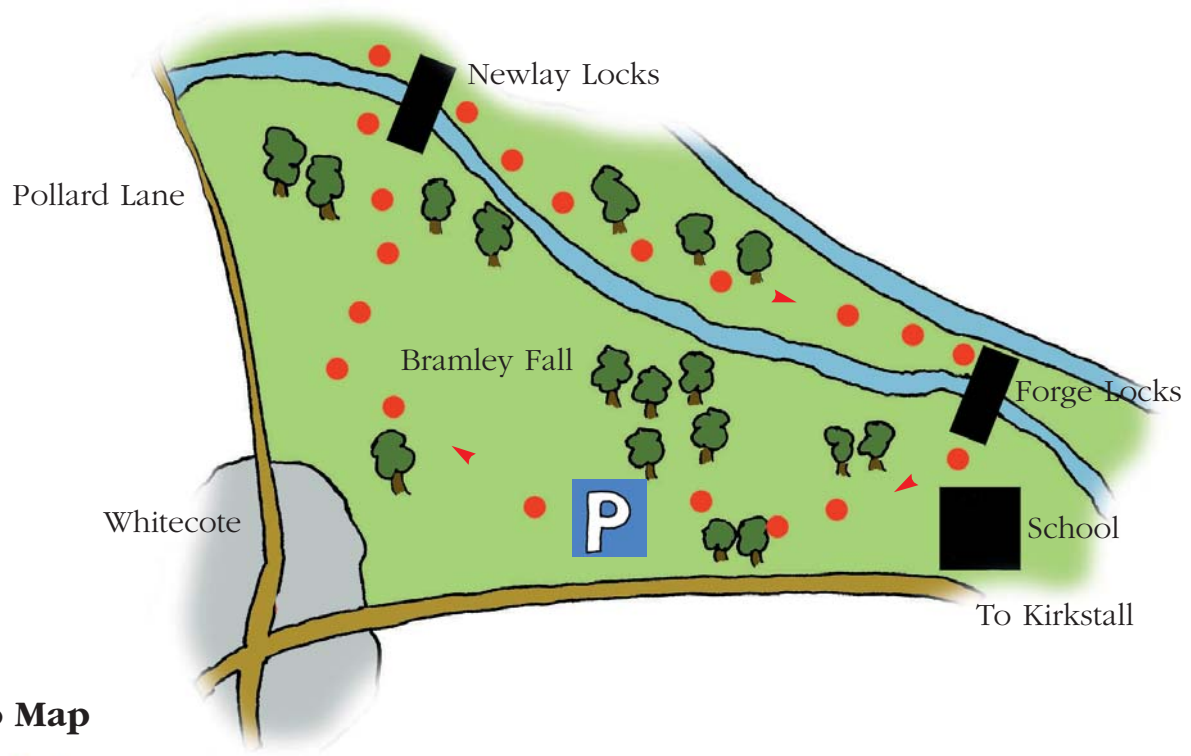
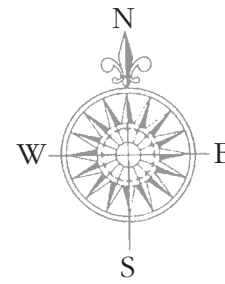

From Bramley Fall Car Park head left down the main track towards the canal. Cross over the canal at Newlay Locks and then turn right following the canal towpath down to the next set of locks. Return back over the canal here and then climb the steps straight in front of you. Follow this path until just before you reach the houses where you turn right. This path then takes you back to the Car Park.
