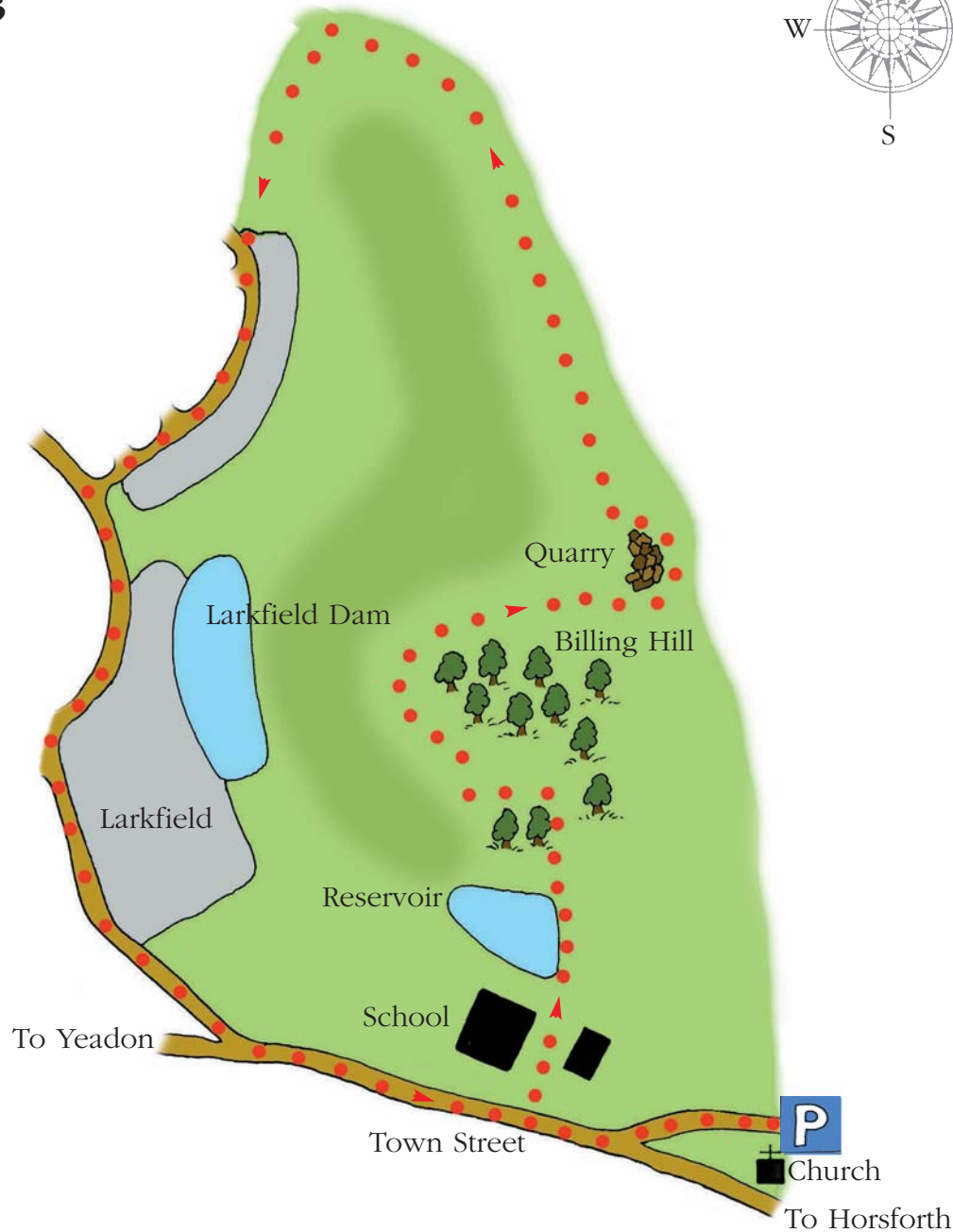

Directions

From the Jubilee Hall car park head past the church on to Town Street. Just past the school there is a footpath on your right, take this and head up past the school towards the playing field. Pass behind the goalposts to a stile in the hedge, follow the path up the next two fields.

After crossing the next stile turn left and walk up the hill to the stile in the top corner of the field. You are now at the top of Billing Hill, it's all downhill from here!

Follow the path round the edge of the quarry and take in the magnificent views on your left.

Take the first stile you pass on your left and head across the top of the slope and follow the path across the next three fields towards the houses. When you reach the houses turn left down the footpath towards Markham Avenue.

Turn left here and then left again at Larkfield Road. This road brings you back to the school where you started.
